


CalEITC - What Is It?

California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC) is a cash back tax credit that puts money back into the pockets of California's low-income working families and individuals so they can better afford the basics Formula based on income and # of children in household

CalEITC - Why is it important?

- Modeled off the Federal EITC, which has been shown to:
 - Lift millions out of poverty Kept 5.7 million people, over half of them children, out of poverty in 2017
 - Boosts local economic growth and builds economic security
 - Improves child and maternal health
 - Children perform better academically, higher high school graduation rates, and higher college attendance rates.



CalEITC - Why is it important?

Unfortunately, many of CA's workers are not eligible for CalEITC





CalEITC - Why is it important?

"[We are going to] more than double the size of the state's Earned Income Tax Credit to \$1 billion. This tax break will support low-income families with young children by providing a \$500 credit for families with children under the age of six. Also, the credit will be expanded to reach full-time workers earning \$15 per hour—reaching 400,000 additional families." - Gov. Newsom
